A SIMPLE APPROACH TO PREDICTABLE ESTHETIC DENTURES

This course will update basic removable procedures, concepts, and materials. Emphasis will be placed on edentulous anatomy, simplified impression procedures for complete and partial dentures, posterior denture occlusion, and the development of skills of communication between the clinician and the laboratory.
